


Axial Skeleton Crossword PARA3002

6. Structure formed by cranial and facial bones.
 10. A rarely used third name for C2, relating to the dens
 13. Area formed by sternum, ribs, and thoracic vertebrae.
 15. The seven vertebrae of the vertebral column located in the neck.
 17. Discs of cartilage between spinal vertebrae
 18. Bony cavities and membranes of the inner ear.
 19. External opening of a canal.

23. Bony protective encasement of the brain and organs of hearing and equilibrium.
 24. A thin layer or flat plate; the portion of a vertebra between the transverse process and the spinous process.
 26. Lower jawbone; U shaped, largest bone of the face.
 27. Number of bones in cranium
 28. Fibrous membrane at the angles of cranial bones that accommodate brain growth in the fetus and infant

Down

1. An enlarged area at the beginning of a canal, i.e., inner ear, nose, larynx.
 2. The cheek(s) of you!
 3. An immovable fibrous joint; with one exception, all bones of the skull are united by sutures.
 4. The natural shapes in the vertebral column
 5. The region where the frontal, parietal, temporal, and sphenoid bones join together
 7. The most abundant cartilage type in the body; provides firm support with some pliability.
 8. Abnormal curvature in the thoracic and lumbar regions
 9. Where the falx cerebri attaches anteriorly to the skull
 11. Allows rotation like an axle
 12. Hole or opening in a bone or between body cavities.
 13. "Process"ing crosswise
 14. Skeleton comprising skull, spinal column, ribcage
 16. Supporting the globe of the head
 20. The bundle of nervous tissue that runs from the brain to the first to third lumbar vertebrae and provides a conduction pathway to and from the brain.
 21. Bone at either side of skull
 22. A horseshoe-shaped bone situated in the anterior midline of the neck
